## FOSH Scholarship Program Information to Applicants

The FOSH Scholarship Program has been created to celebrate and reward students who demonstrate exceptional service to SHS. The scholarships are cash awards that are to be used toward post-secondary tuition or school fees.

### **Eligibility**

Any senior student who will attend a college, university or accredited trade school directly after high school graduation, and who has maintained a minimum of 2.5 GPA on their cumulative high school transcript, is eligible for the scholarship selection process.

### **Application Process**

Students wishing to be considered for the award must submit the following documents to the SHS Guidance Office. *All materials must be submitted no later than **Friday, May 4, 2012** to be considered.*

- A fully completed FOSH Scholarship Application Form
- An essay of 500 words or less describing any activities that have provided service to the school. Examples of such activities include school involvement, community involvement, sports, the arts or academic endeavors. Essays should include details on duration of each activity, impact on the school and whether the activity will continue to benefit the school past the school year and into the future. Students may also provide a list of all significant activities. This list will not be counted against the 500 word limit.
- Two reference letters from individuals familiar with your service activities. References may come from teachers, school administrators, guidance counselors, coaches, activity sponsors, clergymen, or mentors. Letters from family members or personal friends are not acceptable. Student-applicants or their families may not review the letters prior to submission.

### **Selection Process**

All complete applications will be forwarded to the SHS Guidance Office, where GPA's will be confirmed. The Scholarship Committee will then score eligible applications. Scoring will be based on both the essay and recommendations. Scores will reflect the duration of each service activity, the impact of each activity, and the anticipated duration of the impact.

Once applications are scored they will be ranked accordingly. Top applicants will be invited to interview with the Scholarship Committee members. Interviews will be scored and ranked in the same manner as applications. Students with the highest combined application and interview scores will be awarded scholarships. The number of awards is based on the funds available for the program.

### **Awards**

FOSH Scholarship awards will be presented at the Celebration of Service ceremony each spring. Recipients will be required to furnish secondary education information that will allow awards to be sent directly to the school. *Awards will not be given directly to students unless exceptional circumstances are demonstrated.*
